1.1. PURPOSE

2.1 PREPARATION OF THE 2nd DISSEMINATION WORKSHOP

2nd Dissemination workshop was held on April 18, 2016 at the ZAMG in Vienna, Austria during the same week EGU general assembly was held. EGU (egu.eu), the European Geosciences Union, is Europe's premier geosciences union, dedicated to the pursuit of excellence in the Earth, planetary, and space sciences for the benefit of humanity, worldwide. It was established in September 2002 as a merger of the European Geophysical Society (EGS) and the European Union of Geosciences (EUG), and has headquarters in Munich, Germany.

2nd Dissemination workshop was co-organized with the COST Action ES1404 (harmosnow.eu), entitled, "A HARMONISED MONITORING OF SNOW FOR THE BENEFIT OF CLIMATE CHANGE SCENARIOS, HYDROLOGY AND NUMERICAL WEATHER PREDICTION". This COST Action on SNOW aims at building a better connection between snow measurements and models, between snow observers, researchers and forecasters, for the benefit of various stakeholders and the entire society. The main objective of the Action is to enhance the capability of the research community and operational services to provide and exploit quality-assured and comparable regional and global observation-based data on the variability of the state and extent of snow. There are 28 COST countries and Andorra participating to this Action shown in Table 2.1.




Figure 2.1: Registration responses directly from the registration page

The registration responses are shown in Figure 2.1 below.




Figure 2.2: Signed participant list

33 people has participated the workshop in person and participation signed sheet is given in Figure 2.2.
